Cause of Damage:

Sank subsequent to taking water in forward holds while navigating in ice. Sinking likely due to just sea ice but later circumstances make it interesting. Nearest iceberg to locality was noted on the 14th at 13 miles away but no icebergs were observed near the location within a week of the event.

Damage Description:

Hole - 30 to 40cm and other smaller holes in stem 60cm above W/L. Damaged rivets and fractured shell plating. Sank 16 hours later. Crew rescued and arrested fro drug smuggling with several hundred kilograms of cocaine now lying in 50 m of water.
