Damage Description:

Abandoned and sank. Crew landed at Pictou May 28. Rescued by schooner 'John Ramley'. Quebec Gazette #5886 01/06/1842 Page 3, Col. 4B: Captain McDonald, of the brig "Septima", arrived on Monday, reports that on the 9th May, in latitude 47 20N, longitude 46 30W, he saw a sail on his lee bow. apparently in distress. but making no signal. he bore down towards her. when he
